

Privacy Policy and RODO Compliance Statement of Fundacja PACS2 Research Foundation

1. Introduction Fundacja PACS2 Research Foundation ("Foundation") is committed to protecting the privacy and personal data of all individuals we interact with, including patients, researchers, clinicians, public and private institutions. This Privacy Policy outlines how we collect, process, and safeguard personal data in compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) - Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 – and relevant national regulations.

2. Data Controller The Foundation located at Warsaw, Poland, Platkow roz 2/15, 02-757, entered in the Register of Associations kept by the District Court for the Capital City of Warsaw under KRS number: 0000970620, is the data controller responsible for processing personal data.

3. Scope of Data Processing We collect and process personal data for the following purposes:

- Conducting research and collaborations with scientific and medical professionals;
- Facilitating communication between patients, healthcare providers and researchers;
- Organizing events, workshops, and educational initiatives;
- Ensuring compliance with legal and regulatory requirements.

4. Types of Data Processed The personal data we process may include:

- Contact information (name, email, phone number, address).
- Health-related data (only with explicit consent for clearly stated research or support purposes).
- Professional details (affiliations, credentials, areas of expertise).
- Any other data provided voluntarily for engagement with our activities.

5. Legal Basis for Processing We process personal data based on:

- Consent given for each specific purpose (e.g., participation in research, newsletters).
- Legal obligations requiring data collection.
- Legitimate interest in facilitating our goals stated in the Foundation's statute.

6. Data Sharing and Security We do not sell or share personal data with third parties unless required by law or with the data subject's consent. When working with research partners and institutions, data is anonymized whenever possible. We implement technical and organizational measures to ensure data security.

7. Data Retention Personal data is stored only as long as necessary for the purposes outlined above. Retention periods comply with legal and ethical requirements.

8. Data Subject Rights Individuals have the right to:

- Access, rectify, or delete their personal data.
- Restrict or object to data processing.

- Withdraw consent at any time.
- Lodge a complaint with a data protection authority (President of the Personal Data Protection Office in Poland).
